After a year of inactivity, it is in a process of growth and revival and is gaining publicity through organizers' TV interviews on shows like "In the Studio" with Davis Media Access, several websites (most notably, the front page of DavisWiki.org), and soon, hopefully, articles in the Aggie, the Enterprise, and other news periodicals.

When?
